## StudentAccess

### A Partnership for Student Resources

#### What is StudentAccess?

BHM Regional Library and Martin County Schools are partnering to support students' ongoing education. We share the belief that a love of books and learning is a strong foundation for student success and we are working together to provide every Martin County student access to digital materials and resources found online through their public library. We are calling this initiative StudentAccess.

All Martin County students will be able to use their Student ID number to access online public library materials and e-resources such as e-books and e-audiobooks. They will also be able to utilize the Library's online research databases such as NC Live, Mango Languages, and more. More good news is that the student account is free. There are no overdue fines for StudentAccess accounts and, since everything is online, there are no time restrictions; however there is a check-out limit of 10 print items. However, students are responsible for any fees on lost or damaged materials.

#### How does it work?

All students will be automatically enrolled in this program and be able to use their school ID number to access library services. The default PIN is the last 4 digits of the student ID number. If you are a Martin County Public Schools staff member, your NC EdCloud login number or employee ID number will be an Access E-account, giving you instant access to all of BHM Regional Library's online resources.

#### How does this affect my regular library card?

It doesn't! All students with existing BHM cards will keep those cards and use them as they normally would to check out print and/or digital materials. Even if students have fines on their regular BHM card, they will still have access online with their StudentAccess account. The two accounts are not connected and in no way affect one another.

#### Can parents opt out?

Yes. A parent or guardian simply needs to complete an opt-out form and return it to their school's media center, school office, or BHM Regional Library. Forms are available at their school.
